Examples include but are not limited to:

- how you have used UEMS's Section of Psychiatry European Training Requirements (ETR)

- how you have incorporated principles of equality, diversity and inclusion;
- how you have addressed the use of coercive interventions in psychiatric practice;
- how you have incorporated principles of green and sustainable practice.

Judging panel

The panel will be a group composed of members of the Section, Officers, trainees', patients' and family representatives. A minimum of three people will sit on the panel.

The judging panel will declare conflict of interest before considering nominations.
